Nine days ago, late in the afternoon of Aug. 7, Georgian tanks, artillery and infantry began moving out of bases in Georgia and toward South Ossetia, a zone long held by separatists who are backed by Moscow.

As the Georgian units approached the contested zone from the south, **Russian army forces** were massed just to its nort

h, separated from it only by the 4,000-yard-long Roki Tunnel through the Caucasus Mountains.
